The period from 11 May to 31 May 1945 was principally one of training, garrison and police duty for the 409th Infantry Regiment. In addition, the period was used to check equipment and put it in first class condition. On 11 May, Lt.-Col. Hubert E. Strange, of Loogootee, Ind., then commanding the Regiment, held at the Regimental CP a meeting and outlined to his officers the training that was planned for the Regiment during their stay at the various Austrian towns they occupied. This training was to include squad and platoon problems to keep combat operating efficiency high and to correct mistakes which had been made in actual combat. In addition, drill, care of the feet, cleaning and care of weapons, intelligence, artillery .fire, scouting and patrolling were a few of the numerous subjects which occupied the men's training hours.

While not training, the men engaged in guard and road block duty, including the checking of passes, the carrying out of Allied Military Government orders and the protection of vital installations. In accordance with a War Department directive, all men were given an opportunity to see the motion picture "Two Down and One to Go" showing how the discharge point system operated. Adjusted Service Rating cards were made out for the officers and enlisted men to determine their eligibility for discharge. On 15 May, Col. Claudius L. Lloyd, of Baltimore, Md., returned to the Regiment from the hospital and resumed command. On 17 May a foot review of the Declassified per Exec Order 12356, Sec 3.3, NND 735017, by RB/VSW NARA, Date 9/89 Narrative, CT 409, 11-51 May 45 (Cont'd)

Regiment's troops was held on the parade ground at Schwaz (0068), according Col. Lloyd his first opportunity since his return to see his men.

Only one major change was made in the Regimental area during the period. This occurred 13 May when, in accordance with Operations Instruction No. 92, Hq 105d Infantry Division, dated 12 May 1945, the area assigned to the Third Batcalion, 409th Infantry, was extended. For the purpose of conveying the new instructions, Field Order No. 18, dated 12 May 1945, was issued by the Regiment. Third Battalion CP was moved to Hotel Seehof (D994840) on Lake Achensee from Schwaz where it had been formerly located. Regimental CP remained in V omp (D9868), First Battalion in Hall (D850602) and Second Battalion in Wattens (D618916). Company L moved into its new location in Jenbach (0479) at 1730 hours while M Company moved into its new location at Achenkirch (8919) at 1805 hours.

An honor came to the 409th Infantry Regiment 29 May when at a Division review in Innsbruck Combat Infantry streamers were affixed to Regiment, Battalion and Company flags. The streamers acknowledge the fact that 65% of the strength of such units have been awarded the Combat Infantryman Badge. Two other distinctions came to the Regiment during the period. The first Distinguished Service Cross awarded in the Regiment was awarded posthumously to Pfc. Wilson F. Rodgers, of Tacoma, Wash., of K Company, 409th Infantry, for action near Taintrux, France, on 14-16 November 1944. The other honor was the award of the Legion of Merit—the first such in the Regiment—to Major Julius J. Urban, of Jackson Heights, N. Y., for exceptionally meritorious work from 9 November 1944 to 25 March 1945.

Narrative, CT 409, 11-51 May 45 (Cont'a)

Two officer promotions came during the month, these coming to Joseph L. Turecek, MAC, who won a battlefield promotion to first lieutenant, and to Owen A Dupont, Infantry, commanding Antitank Company, to the rank of captain.

The last 21 days of May were not all work days for the men of the 409th Infantry Regiment. Entertainment was one of the foremost concerns of the Cactusmen, K Company at Schwaz at an old cafe near their area and Headquarters Company at Vomp were among the first companies opened taprooms. K's was called the Kommando Club and Headquarters was called Dad's Alpine Club. Frequent movies and shows were held throughout the Regimental area. A rest center was set up at Lake Achensee with 1st Lt. Allen R. Arrison, of Los Angeles, Calif., in charge. Each company was allotted a period of stay at the rest center where movies, boating and various forms of recreation were enjoyed.

In addition, daily quotas were given for trips to Innsbruck for the 103d Infantry Division's Enlisted Men's Club where skiing and other recreation was enjoyed. Current regimental quotas to Nancy, Riveria, Great Britain and Paris rest centers were filled.

Memorial Day, May 30, was considered a holiday by order of the 105d Infantry Division and higher headquarters and training schedules were cancelled for the troops. A memorial service was conducted at which time Lt.-Col. Strange read a list of the men of the Regiment who have been killed in action.

# AWARD, POSTHUMOUS, OF THE DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS

Awarded by GO #163, Hq Seventh Army, dtd 25 Apr 45 to WILSON F RODGERS, 39209620, Private First Class, Infantry, Company "K", 409th Infantry Regiment, for extraordinary heroism in action from 14 November to 16 November 1944, in the vicinity of Taintrux, France. On 14 November 1944, Private First Class Rodgers voluntarily led an eight-man patrol into Taintrux, returning twice during the night, and then remaining in an observation post through the next day obtaining valuable information relative to enemy dispositions. With this vital information, Company K, with Private First Class Rodgers' squad in the lead, launched an attack against the well-prepared enemy positions. When his squad was pinned down by intense enemy machine gun fire, Private First Class Rodgers fearlessly dashed forward to eliminate the hostile emplacement but, while so engaged, he was fatally wounded. His comrades, inspired by his outstanding courage and self-sacrifice, vigorously renewed their attack and captured the town. Next of kin: Mr. Bynest F.
