NARRATIVE 409th INFANTRY REGIMENT For the Month of Dec 1944

The campaign to capture Selestat (7962), begun 27 Nov, continued unabated on 1 December. Operations Instructions No. 18 from Division specified that the 409th Infantry would attack in its zone and seize its objective, which was the city itself. The 410th and 411th Infantries and Combat Command A of the 14th Armored Division advanced on our left; on our right was the 56th Division. The 1st Battalion was ordered to seize, occupy and establish two road blocks in the northern half of the city and moved out at 1305. The 2d Battalion, moving out abreast, was to maintain contact with the 36th Division. The 5d Battalion remained at St Maurice (704696) in reserve. Attached to our unit was Company B (less two platoons), 756th Tank Battalion. Scherwiller (7665) was occupied early in the afternoon. Mist in the zone of operations was heavy, obscuring targets and precluding observed artillery missions. The rains of the Vosges were behind us; the snow and cold of the open plains lay before us.

Shortly after midnight the 1st Battalion had advanced as far as the railroad tracks in the northern end of Selestat. Company B, with the 1st Platoon of Company D in support, had reached a point on the main road to town at about 2200 the previous evening. Small arms fire was heard to the front and the bazooka and riflemen of Company B moved up leaving the rear and flanks of the Company D CLASSIFICATION. Company B launched an attack across the river, quickly main that captured and cleared the first six houses and posted and cleared the first six houses and

Company D followed, one section occupying the first house on the right across the river, another section occupying a building opposite. A gun was set on the window covering the road.

At 0330 three tanks rumbled down the road and without further warning opened up at short range on the buildings occupied by our troops, pouring round after round into them. The tanks were the screen for enemy infantry in far superior numbers armed with automatic weapons. The occupants of the first few houses, representing most of Company B, were quickly forced to surrender and herded away down the road. The Germans then turned their attention to the other buildings.

Several men of Company B ran out of their billet through the rear door and so close was the enemy upon them that the last man attempting to get away was captured. The others ran into an adjoining building. As the first man entered, a German sprang at him and grabbed his rifle. His companions came in close behind and the Germans who were there, three in number, surrendered. They were disarmed and made to lie down on the floor. A tank drew up and fired four rounds into the house. These were followed by four concussion grenades, but everyone remained quiet believing that if they could hold out until the next morning Companies A and C would come to their aid. This proved to be the case for at 1000, 2 December, T/Sgt L G Allen, 6924484, from Franklin, Tennessee, who was subsequently awarded a Silver Star, Missing in Action, for his participation in this phase of the fighting, came into the house with a patrol from Company A. Some of the men joined Company C in the attack while others re-



mained behind to look after the wounded and guard the prisoners.

The men from Company D in the billet on the right side of the road had, in the meanwhile, also been attacked by two of the tanks and an unknown number of infantry. An attempt to give up was disregarded and met with renewed fire from the enemy. After the Germans ceased firing four of the Company D men and four riflemen escaped through a hole in the rear wall made by one of the tank guns. As they were running away from the house they turned and saw the Germans come up and capture the remainder of the men who were coming out. The eight men returned safely to Dambach la Ville (770695).

Pfc Harold F Bausch, 36288100, Medical Detachment, 1st Fattalion, from Lancaster, Wisconsin, was the Company B aid man the night of the attack. When the enemy tanks first opened up he was in one of the rooms in the building. After the first few rounds he heard someone call for a Medic. He attempted to reach the wounded and get them to safety but another blast from the tanks smoked up the house and jarred him. When he surrendered he was marched down the street with the rest of the Company, but the Germans removed him and an aid man from Company D from the ranks of the marchers and escorted them back to the house to attend the wounded. The walking wounded were marched along with the rest of the prisoners.

Two guards were placed over the Medics. At daylight Pfc Bausch sighted our tanks across the river. He left the other aid man to watch the wounded and escaped to get help. He then returned and remained with the casualties until Sunday morning, 3 December, when he helped evacuate them to the Bat-

talion Aid Station.

About 15 of all the men in Company B who had crossed the river managed to escape.

and moved over the railroad tracks on the West edge of town. Effective at 0750 Company B (minus two platoons), 756 Tank Battalion, was relieved from attachment to the 409th and replaced by one platoon, Company C, 601st TD Battalion. In the early afternoon permission was received from the Commanding General to use a company of the 48th Tank Battalion in support of our troops in Selestat where they were encountering stiff resistance in the form of armor, artillery, mortar, automatic weapons and road blocks that were heavily protected by high concentrations of fire power and troops.

The fight for Selestat continued, the infantry forced to battle alone during the morning of the 5d because armor could not cross the stream. Tank Destroyers entered the town in the afternoon and infantry units were assigned to them to protect them from AT fire. At 1715 Task Force Selestat was created for the specific purpose of capturing Selestat. It consisted of the 409th Infantry; Company A, 528th Engineer (C) Battalion; Company A, 328th Medical Battalion; Company B, 756th Tank Battalion, Companies B and C, 601st TD Battalion; and Company C, 3d Chemical Battalion. The forces were to function as Tank-Infantry Combat Teams. Companies A, C, E and F of the 409th were organized into assault teams with Company G following the main body at about 400 yards.

A PW reported on the morning of the 4th that the American soldiers cap-

tured in Selestat were taken to Mutterholtz (8653). Company K was sent in to reinforce the 1st Battalion, outpost the rear left flank and patrol between the battalion and a French-Canadian unit when the 410th was relieved. By 1325 Company E had reached the R-line and begun to fan out to the South to contact the 36th Division. By 1645 the city was completely taken and occupied.

Elements of the 142d Infantry on the right effected relief of elements of Task Force Selestat in accordance with FO #5, Task Force Selestat. Relief was successfully accomplished during the night, control of the area officially passing to the 36th Division at 0500, 5 December, and the Task Force members assembled in the vicinity of Scherwiller, Dieffenthal (765679) and Dambach la Ville. The 5d Battalion closed in Truchtersheim (9407) at 2000. By the end of the day preparations were practically completed for the movement by motor of the rest of our units to the assembly area in the North.

The 409th moved out early in the morning of the 6th. The Regimental CP reopened at Reitwiller (912087) at 1105. The 1st Battalion closed in Truchtersheim at 1245, the 2d at 1400.

Company E was designated to guard the Division CP at Gougenheim (8711) and closed in its area there at 0900 on the 7th. The 3d Battalion received a spurious order and overlay covering relief of the 79th Division designed as a subterfuge to confuse the enemy. To lend authenticity to the deception a reconnaissance party was even dispatched to survey proposed positions. The day was otherwise devoted to firing the bazooka by troops for more complete familiarization.

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The 8th found the 409th still in Division Reserve. Company B arrived at La Walck (5027) to guard the new Division CP. Company E was relieved at approximately 1200 when the old Division CP closed at Gougenheim. The 2d Battalion moved to Schalkendorf (8726), arriving there at 1330.

Company A left at 0723 on the 9th for Dauendorf (941257) to join Task

Force Forest, a unit designed to protect the Division flanks by patrolling the

right and left boundaries and maintaining contact with the 79th and 45th Divi
sions, respectively. For the remainder of the day and all of the next the

Regiment jockeyed around to new locations, preparatory to taking up its as
signed positions in the lines.

On the 11th the Regiment, less 1st Battalion (-Company A) which was in Division Reserve, moved into its assembly area in the vicinity of Forstheim (985330) prepared to pass through the 410th Infantry and take its place in the Division zone between the other two regiments after the 410th took Laubach (9831). The 409th was then to press the attack in its own middle sector. The immediate objective after commitment was to be the town of Morsbronn-les Bains (0033) from whence the Regiment was to forge its way to Phase Line L and prepare to continue the attack on Division order. Attached to the 409th for this operation was lie platoon of Company B, 756th Tank Battalion, and Company B (- one platoon), 614th TD Battalion (Towed). The 382d Field Artillery Battalion, initially in general support of the Division, was to provide direct support for the 409th when it was committed.

The CP arrived at Mertzwiller (9650) at 1100. At noon the 3d Battalion moved into the gap between the 410th and 411th and at approximately 1330 it

entered Morsbronn without resistance; at 1525 it was overlooking Phase Line L; and by darkness it commanded the heights above the river West of Gunstett (0255). Company I crossed the river under cover of darkness, meeting stiff resistance from enemy mortars and machine guns but succeeding in establishing a bridgehead and taking part of the town.

The 1st Battalion (-) reverted to Regimental control at 1500 on the 12th and moved to the vicinity of Gunstett. The 2d Battalion captured Kutzenhausen (087370) and dug in for the night. Orders were issued for slipping the 2d Battalion into the right half of our zone when we were about 2000 yards short of the K-line. The two battalions would then advance abreast, the 2d on the South. The 5d Battalion took Merkwiller (0738), Pechelbronn (068375) and dug in for the night.

On the 13th, the 14th Armored Division occupied the right flank of the Regiment. Our 3d Battalion was relieved by the 2d and reverted to Regimental Reserve. The mission of the 409th (attached Company B, 614th TD Battalion) for the day was to attack at 0830 and seize Soultz (109376) and the road leading Northwest from there in its zone. The 2d Battalion (attached 2d platoon, Company B, 756th Tank Battalion) was given this assignment. It was further briefed to remain prepared to attack after seizure and before. The 14th Armored Division might pass through the Battalion en route to Soultz; they might take Soultz, but the 2d Battalion was not to wait for this action to occur. It was to take the initiative, push on to its objective and pay particular attention to the South and East flanks. The 1st and 2d Battalions spearheaded the attack; the former took Lobsann (082405) and Memelshoffen (098400), the latter took Soultz and Retschwiller (107390). Maginot forts were not defended.

For the 14th the 409th was to attack and seize Phase Line F, and protect the Division right flank North of Phase Line B. A company of the 47th Tank Battalion relieved our attached Company B, 756th Tank Battalion at RJ 064578. The 2d Battalion pushed off at 0730 and took Bremmelbach (1243) before noon. Companies A and C took Brachenbronn (098432) at 1150. The 1st Battalion entered Cleebourg (114450) without opposition at 1438. The two battalions were ordered to button up on the E-line. Permission was requested of the Commanding General and granted to extend our zone to include Steinselts (143457) and Oberhofen (137464) in the morning. We were to return to our original zone after clearing the towns.

The 1st and 2d Battalions were instructed to move back to our zone of action before reaching the F-line after taking Steinseltz and Oberhoffen. They were to lean to the Begiment's left boundary and miss Wissembourg (153487), objective of the 14th Armored Division, completely. At 0800 Company G with five tanks in support jumped off to seize the town of Steinseltz while Company E prepared to support the attack. A runner was sent out to stop the church bell from ringing for it was said that it was a signal for the enemy to zero in. The tanks entered the town at 0922 with Company G close behind. They moved through with no opposition and Oberhoffen was taken shortly afterwards. Company G was left in the towns to protect our flanks and the rest of the Battalion swung North to participate in the main Regimental effort on the town of Rott (125470) which had been occupying the attention of the 1st Battalion since its jump-ff at 0750, that morning of the 17th. After furious fighting both battalions coordinated in capturing the town. The 3d Battalion, with

the exception of Company K which had been committed to patrol the Regiment's
left boundary and act as contact liaison between the 411th and our 1st Battalion, remained in Cleebourg as Regimental Reserve.

The next day, the 16th, the 1st and 2d Battalions renewed their attack, capturing Weiler (127487). They reached their objective at the H-line shortly before dark and settled down for the night.

The 17th saw much patrol activity. Patrols were sent forward to probe the Siegfried defenses as far as the K-line. Preparations were made to continue the attack on Division order and contact was maintained with the 41lth. The 409th made no attempt to move because it was too far ahead of the rest of the Army front.

The Regiment was ordered to attack at 1100 of the 18th proceeding only as far as the J-line and not going beyond except on Division order. The forward CP displaced to Rechtenbach, Germany. The town was entirely empty of civilians. Evidence was visible everywhere that departure had been hasty. No personal belongings or furniture had been taken and some homes still bore traces of hot meals that had been prepared but never eaten. The 1st Battalion was unable to jump off on time due to artillery fire on its left front from the 41lth; its right Company was waiting for a patrol to return. The 2d Battalion took off across the valley at 1145 encountering no opposition. It was unable to determine whether pill boxes were manned although some empty ones were passed. Information was received that Combat Command A, disorganized, was withdrawing from Ober-Otterbach (172524) and reforming. The possibility of impressing our Reserve Battalion to protect our right flank, left open by this action, was considered. Company C took Hill 489 (145540) which included three concrete bunkers,

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one on top of the hill and two on the slopes protecting it. The bunkers were reinforced with steel and were connected by tunnels.

The objective for the 19th remained the same. Company A secured a position just Northeast of Hill 543 (136545) while Company B maneuvered to a position on Hill 489 to the left of Company C sustained a counterattack from what was estimated to be a German battalion but it was driven off without loss.

Company E strengthened its positions on Hohenberg Hill (159532), finally moving into the saddle between it and Grassberg Hill (154538). Company F remained on the high ground of Ebmung Hill (168525). Company G extended the Battalion flank to cover Grassberg Hill. Company I protected the right flank of the Regiment due to the withdrawal of Combat Command A for reorganization. Three officers and a platoon from Company E entered a pill box that, unknown to them, still contained one of the enemy, who locked them in. The enemy had a machine gun nest outside of the pill box and another platoon is trying to wipe it out and release the trapped men. Company G approached one pill box on its blind side and blew it up with 40 lbs of TNT against an embrasure, capturing 16 prisoners who were poorly fed and clothed?

The weather on the 20th was misty and overcast and the 1st and 2d Battalions continued to secure their positions. Low clouds precluded any air support.

Occasional snow also fell. The enemy launched several counterattacks which were
supported by tanks during the morning and afternoon but all were repulsed.

Heavy artillery and mortar fire was being poured into our troops. It was discovered that the enemy, with great resourcefulness, was reoccupying the trenches
we vacated under bombardment.

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The Regiment was ordered to continue its aggressive reconnaissance by fire on the 21st using all weapons, to conduct patrolling without any involvement in any heavy attack and to shoot at, but not assault, pill boxes. At about 0200 a stubborn attacked was directed against Companies B and C by the enemy using flame throwers and Molotov cocktails. The besieged companies consolidated their strength for a perimeter defense and successfully repulsed the threat, the enemy withdrawing at about 0330. Both battalions called for harmsing fires during the early hours of the night with special concentrations on Bollenborn (147554) and Dorrenbach (165545).

An advance party from the 45th Division came to the Regimental CP to discuss details of relief and was oriented on the ground during the night and in the early morning of the following day. Shortly before midnight March Order No. 5 detailing plans for our projected move to an assembly area in the vicinity of Hundling (4465), was issued to all organizations and attached units of our command.

At 0015 of the 22d the vicinity of our assembly area was changed to Insming (370404) and Annex No. 1 to March Order No. 5 was prepared to incorporate the change. The Regiment was relieved in its zone by elements of the 2d and 3d Battalions, 179th Infantry. The relieving units moved in behind our front lines during the night and relief, started at dawn, was completed at 1101, Colonel Murphy, Commanding Officer of the 179th, assuming command of the zone. AT and Cannon Companies closed into their assembly areas at Hellimer (357447) at 1650.

At 0950 of the 23d the Regt closed in its assembly area. Company B was sent to protect the Division CP at Franceltroff (314408). Units were alerted to a G-2 report that 16 German paratroops had landed in grid 4035; they were thought to be in American uniforms and might know the password. This was the first indication of reports of enemy paratroopers in the vicinity, flares, and strafing planes and rumors of imminent enemy attack that began to appear almost daily until the end of the month.

On the 24th the Regiment moved to forward assembly areas behind the 410th and 41lth Infantries. Reconnaiseance was conducted and plans made for local defense. Relief of the 6th Armored Division by elements of the 103d Division was accomplished at 1642, but verbal permission was received from XV Corps to retain protection of the tanks in our zone during the 25th in case their assistance might be required.

From the 25th to the end of the month defensive preparations were made to cover the Regimental zone. Reconnaissance was conducted for positions and plans were submitted for defensive fires. The remainder of the day was spent placing AT guns in position, reconnoitering for rear positions and digging gun emplacements. Plans were prepared for submission to Division Engineer for necessary road blocks and bridge demolitions. Orders were issued to have work start on the 26th on positions reconnoitered the previous day. Work progressed rapidly on the establishment of AA- and BB-lines and orientation of Commanding Officers and their staffs on counterattack plans and ground positions. By the 27th approximately 50% of the work was completed; another 25% was added the 28th. By

the 29th AT and Cannon Company positions were completed. Division gave the Regiment 10 bridges to guard.

Battalions and Separate Companies were placed on an alert status beginning at 0500 of the 30th, work on defensive lines being suspended until
further notice. At 0912 Division ordered work to be resumed. The Regiment
was also given 27 more bridges to guard, some having engineer troops on duty
for demolition only. A 3-man guard system was adopted: one to stop vehicles,
one to cover him and the third man to sleep. Preparation of positions neared
completion.

By the end of the period tactical wire was 80% complete. Positions were almost finished and the Regiment settled down to the prospect of an hitherto unassigned mission, a holding action.
