1930 (con'd) d. Res Co must be able to be assembled in 40 mins. after your receipt of alert order.

- 2. Prepare and submit plan to raid enemy position Vic 499582. Raid to be conducted at 1830 on 2 Jan 45, simultaneously with raid to be made vic 514530 by 114th Inf. 1st Plat, Co A, 43rd Tk Bn attached to you for this operation only-coordinate directly with CO 1st Bn re availability of Plat Idr for planning and reconnaissance. Up to 4 Bns Div Arty are available for fire support. Other than above, support raid with your own organic and attached weapons. Not to exceed 2 reinforced rifle platoons to be employed. Mission: a. Dominate no-man's land. b. Capture at least one prisoner, together with such documents as may
- b. Capture at least one prisoner, together with such documents as may be found.

c. Effect maximum practicable destruction of enemy personnel, vehicles, weapons and supplies in raided area.

- 2300 15 man patrol reported heading S to WELFERDING. Believed to be only civilians trying to obtain passage thru our lines. At this time 39 civilians have been picked up and returned to Fatal PW cage.
- 2330 Following report from Fatal 3:
 Enemy attack in zone of Mustang. Received heavy arty fire and report
 1 tank. 44th Div in center of zone and on right Regt. Enemy strength
 as 1 enemy En against center of Div and 5 enemy cos against right Regt.

1 Jan 1945

- 0030 One French civilian captured by F Co. Believed to have been former French officer. He reports following: SP's in vic of ZINZINGEN. These vehicles move to GROSBLIEDERSTROFF and LININGEN to fire on our troops. Bridge at 48.7-66.8 definitely out.
- 0330 Co E OP #1 reports 1 enemy vehicle moving in vicinity of hospital.
- 0500 Fatal 3 reports PW captured by 44th Div reports 4 panzer Divs set to attack 103d Div.
- 0600 Message received from Fatal 6 that MG positions must be manned on MLR as well as OPLR. Overlay of all MG positions must be in to Regt by 0900.
- 0850 40 more civilians picked up by Co E. Returned to Fatal PW cage.

0900 MG position overlay sent to Fatal 6.

- 1230 Fatal 6 visits Bn CP. Bn S-6 and Fatal 6 agree on defensive positions of MG's. Plans for night raid submitted to Fatal6. Copy of plans also sent to Co G.
- 1315 Fatal 6 leaves Bn CP.
- 1500 Division Chief of Staff visits Bn CP.
- 2100 Summary of Day's fighting of adjacent units:
 44th Div Heavy Inf combat all day supported by 5 to 7 tanks with no Arty
 preparation preceding attack. Enemy have made slight penetration on right
 to coordinates 60-56. As of 1815 44th Div unable to take back lost ground.
 PW captured states large attack to be made 2 Jan. Seven Inf Bns identified
 but strength unknown.

100th Div - In small arms combat most of day but no ground lost. Reports

tank column penetration at 1730 to coordinates 79-42 near MUDERHOUSE, however, Corps reports this as only a patrol. Air activity heavy over HUMBERG - 15 enemy planes shot down. MUSTANG - Enemy has been reinforced in this sector but except for little skirmish at 1700 the attack is quieted down.

2 Jan 1945

0700 Action during night very quiet.

0900 Bn S-2 leaves for Co E to inspect defensive positions.

0900 Message from Bn S-6 to H-6: Continue work as you did yesterday. Check to assure each firing position has stakes out, range cards prepared, and positions equipped with grenades. Situation unchanged in general. Tonite's raid set back one hour to 1930.

1015 Message from Fatal 6 to Bn S-6: In event of receipt of orders from this Hq to withdraw Bn CO's are authorized to execute all barriers in their Bn sectors north of the Regimental Res Line inclusive. All other barriers in the Regtl sector will be executed only upon authority of the Div Engr.

- 1100 Message from Bn S-6 to CO's Co's E and G: Co G will relieve elements of Co E in rt sector of Bn Zone during daylight hours, relief to be completed by 1700 3 Jan 45. Relieving Co will take over present Co E installations and continue improvements of all positions. Co E will revert to Bn Res Line; also will be called on to furnish town guards and necessary patrols called for. Ex O and 1 NCO per plat, Co E will remain with relieving elements, Co G for period of 24 hours to facilitate relief at 0900 3 Jan 45, CO CO G, plat ldrs and plat guides (or Plat Sgts) will meet Co E CO and 1 Plat Guide per plat at Co E CP to plan and make Rcn for relief. Security measures will be given strictest attention. Present Ammo loads on position, range cards, AP mines and other fire data will be turned over to relieving unit.
- 1130 Bn S-2 returns to Bn CP.
- 1300 G-6 leaves Bn CP for front tomake final preparations for night raid.
- 1400 Bn S-6 and S-3 leave for 3rd Bn to reconnoiter Regtl Res Line.
- 1500 Lt Pierce, 328th Engr, leaves for mill to contact G-6 to make final preparations and arrangements for proposed river crossing.
- 1715 3rd Plat, G Co. leaves HUNDLING for assembly area prior to raid.
- 1730 Bn S-6 and S-3 return to Bn CP.
- 1800 Bn S-2 and Arty Ln O leave for mill.
- 1900 Bn S-5 leaves for raid area.
- 1935 Night raid jumped off at 1930 as planned.
- 2015 Raid on schedule. Crossing completed. Searching first buildings.
- 2037 Message from Flapjack Blue 5: Holding up night raid for more light.
- 2115 Raiding party still searching buildings. Bn requests 1/2 hr reports. Reported progress phoned to Fatal 3.
- 2130 E-6 reports sound of siren to NE of Co E. CP #2 at considerable distance. Message from Flapjack Blue 5: Our raiding party to jump off at 2200 providing better light.
- 2145 No enemy contact reported by raiders as yet.
- 2200 Rear elements of raiders reported at coordinates 50.0-57.6. No enemy contact reported.
- 2215 No enemy action. Enemy flares fired at considerable distance from front. Message from Flapjack Blue 5: Raid called off -- too dark.
- 2240 Raiding plat reached objective. No enemy action. Patrol returning.

- 2250 Co F captures 1 prisoner in vicinity of road block. PW states he is one man of 5 man patrol: 3 killed by Arty, 1 lost and he gives himself up. He also reports 2nd patrol ordered to leave at 2400 on same mission.
- 2300 Raiding Plat re-crosses SAAR River to our lines. Nothing found except evidence that Germans pulled out 2 days previous. Above reported to Fatal 3 and Flapjack Blue 2.

3 Jan 1945 0700 Everything quiet. Bn still defending right sector of Regtl zone.

0915 Co E captures 2 prisoners.

0950 Fatal 6 arrives Bn CP and leaves following message: In view of unsuccessful raid tonight, conduct rigorous and aggressive patrolling tomorrow night and develop plan for conducting another raid not later than 5 Jan. Place for new raid to be recommended by you.

1000 Fatal 6 leaves Bn CP.

1130 Fatal 6 returns to Bn CP.

- 1400 2 squads of Co E ordered to send patrols to following vicinities: 488614 and 482616. Patrol leaders briefed by Bn S-2 on mission.
- 1445 Bn S-3 and S-2 and patrol leaders leave for Co F area to reconnoiter routesand observe.
- 1645 Bn S-3 and S-2 return to Bn CP. Patrols all ready to go out on mission.

1700 Relief of Co E completed by Co G.

- 1945 Co F patrol of 4 menleave Co CP to reconnoiter cave 400 yards to front.
- 2010 Both Co E patrols contact outpost enroute on mission. Squad leaders jumped off from Co F CP instead of Co F OPs.

4 Jan 1945

- 0215 Co E patrol leaders return to Bn CP. No Germans contacted. Still lacking information on strength of enemy SW of GROSBLIEDERSTROFF.
- 0700 Action during night very light. Bn still in defense on right sector of Regtl Zone. 3rd Bn now on our immediate right.

1100 Fatal 5 arrives at Bn CP.

- 1130 Bn S-3 contacts 114th Inf on result of their patrols last night.
- 1200 Fatal 5 leaves Bn CP as Fatal 6 arrives at Bn CP.
- 1300 Bn S-3 returns to Bn CP.
- 1315 Fatal 6 leaves Bn CP.
- 1330 Bn S-2 briefs squad leaders of Co E who are to make 2 patrols tonight to 485615 and 485617. Mission: to find exact position of enemy. Use fire power if necessary and enter town completely to accomplish mission.

1630 2 squads of Co E leave for Co F OPs.

- 1900 Enemy tanks reported at critical point 93. FATIMA moves tanks, TDs and bazookas to eliminate same. Reported to FATAL 3.
- 2045 Patrols of Co E pass through Co F outpost.

5 Jan 1945

- 0030 Patrols of Co E return through Co F outpost.
- 0200 Patrol leaders reported to Bn CP. Result of Patrol: Location of MG spotted at Vic of RJ at coordinates 479614. 1 sentinel in Vic 485-616. No enemy captured.

0700 Action during night very quiet. F andG Cos made contact by patrols during night. Bn still in defensive action in right zone of Regtl sector.

0900 Started defense plans on night raid to be conducted by 1st Plat, Co E.

- 1100 First Plat Ldr, Co E, Bn S-3 and Bn S-2 discuss plans.
- 1130 Fatal 6 confers with Fatal White 6. Consents for us to conduct raid night of 6 Jan 45.
- 1230 Fatal 6 visits Bn CP.
- 1315 81mm mortars report registration complete with concentration numbers given: 55(483616) and 56(479615).
- 1400 Fatal 6 and Bn 6 leave to inspect Co F area.
- 1630 Bn S-6 returns to Bn CP.
- 1930 Plans for night raid, 6 Jan 45, submitted to Fatal.
- 2215 Fatal 6 arrives at Bn CP. Cancels raid scheduled for 6 Jan 45.
- 2250 Fatal 6 leaves Bn CP.
- 6 Jan 1945
- 0010 Bn S-5 ordered to report to Fatal 5 at 0800 6 January 45.
- 0745 Bn S-5 leaves for Fatal 5.

- 2110 Order issued to Co G to repeat raid staged 2 Jan 45 at 0530 7 Jan 45. One section LMG and one BAR team of Co E attached to Co G for raid.
- 2115 Fatal 6 leaves Bn CP.

- 1645 Fatal 6 arrives at Bn CP.
- 1705 Fatal 6 leaves Bn CP.
- 1830 Raiding party, 1st Plat Co E leaves ROUHLING. Communications all right.

- 2320 Raiding platoon reports passing of objective #1 and #2. House at objective #1 recently occupied. Telephone found.
- 2325 Raiding platoon request artillery concentration "E".
- 0230 Raiding party commander returns to Bn CP. Results of Raid: Enemy OP at Objective #3 routed. No prisoners captured. However, artillery and mortar fire very effective. Patrol returns in their parkas, used by troops in last few raids, proved very satisfactory in camouflage aswell as warmth.
- 0700 Other than raid, night veryquiet. Co G reports single shot fired from across river. G Co doubled guard.
- 0915 Bn S-2 leaves for Co G.
- 0930 Bn S-6 and Bn S-3 leave for meeting with E-6 and H-6 to prepared new positions.
- 0945 Bn S-2 returns.
- 1045 Division G-2 arrives at Bn CP.
- 1115 Division G-2 leaves Bn CP.
- 1315 Bn S-6 and Bn S-3 return to Bn CP.
- 1400 February 6 pays visit to Bn CP.
- 1500 February 6 leaves Bn CP.
- 1530 Bn S-3 reports to Fatal 5.
- 1635 Fatal 6 arrives at Bn CP.
 1700 Message from Fatal 6 to Fatal White 6: Investigate report that German ammunition is stored in cave at approximately 489604. - 1710 Message from Fatal 6 to Fatal White 6: Your recommendation for repeating raidVic GROSBLIEDERSDORF night 9-10 Jan, without change in plans from those of night raid 7-8 Jan on same area, is approved. Plans need not be resubmitted. Coordinate direct with 383rd FA Bn.
- 1715 Fatal 6 leaves Bn CP.
- 1730 Bn S-3 returns to Bn CP. Demonstration postponed until 10 Jan 45.
- 1830 Rcn patrol of 6 men, Co E, leave on listening post mission to GROSBLIED-ERSDORF.
- 2200 Patrol returns. Report no German activity Vic of cemetery.
- 9 Jan 1945
- 0700 All quiet in "No Man's Land" during night. En continues to defend right sector of Regtl zone.
- 0900 Message from Fatal White 6 to Fox 6: Send patrol to cave Vic 489604 to investigate German Ammo reported there. Notify this Hqs as to amount and type if found: (1) Panzerfaust (2) Grenades (3) other Ammo. Estimate any assistance needed to remove same.
- 1000 Bn S-5 leaves for Fatal meeting.
- 1050 Fatal 3 arrives at Bn CP.
- 1145 Covering force plan of withdrawl submitted to Fatal 3.
- 1300 Bn S-5 returns to Bn CP.
- 1345 Fatal 3 leaves Bn CP.
- 1540 G-1 reports 6 88mm shells landing 250 yards in front of their area--two of which were duds coming from NE.

- 1620 G-1 reports 3 rounds of artillery or 88s falling vic of large cave from NE appear to be zeroing in on mouth of cave.
- 1630 G-1 reports 8 rounds artillery falling vic of his OP and large cave coming in from NE.
- 1630 Message from Fatal White 6 to Fatal 6: Investigation of cave vic 489604 reveals: 200rds 88 amm; 200 rds mortar; 50-75 rds AT; 2000 rds rifle;
- 50 boxes sub MG; 200 boxes P-38 pistol; 23 55 gal drums gasoline.
 1730 Message from Fatal White 6 to Fatal 6: Will attempt to remove ammo from cave tenight of 10 Jan 45 beginning 1830. 1 sqd, Co F, to act as guides and covering force; 2 squds, Co E and Bn A&P Plat, will serve as carrying party to remove ammo to point in woods vic 483597 where it will be loaded on one 2 1/2 ton truck under direction of A & P Plat Ldr.

1920 Bn S-3 leaves for Co F CP.

10 Jan 1945

0205 Lt Doggett leaves with platoon for Co F CP.

- 0315 Received word I&R patrol encountered SA, burp gun and MG fire east of GROSBLITTERSDORF.
- 0430 1st Plat, Co E, arrives at Co F CP. Raid cancelled as time required to complete raid insufficient. Hazardous night driving reason for being late.
- 0830 Bn S-6 leaves for Blue Bn CP for meeting of Bn COs. Bn S-3 leaves F Co CP for Blue Bn for same meeting.
- 0930 Message from Fatal White 5 to H-6: Four 50 cal. MG with crews will report to Fox Co CP as close to 1000 today if possible (take reasonable amount of ammo). Detail will be for today and tonight. Bring necessary equipment.
- 1150 Bn S-6 and S-3 return to Bn CP. 411th Inf to attack in their zone of action at 1315 for approximately 2 km. 410th Inf mission is to hold present positions and support by fire 411th advance.
- 1200 Bn S-6 holds meeting with Co COs orienting them on above information.
- 1430 Bn S-2 leaves to contact February 2.
- 1600 Bn S-2 returns to Bn CP.
- 1630 Fatal reports 411th Inf on objective and occupied with little resistance. 4 H Co 50 cal MG released to be returned to company control.
- 1730 6 rounds 88 land in front of mill in WELFERDING occupied by G Company.
- 1740 Tank movements in front of Co G OP #1. Unable to determine number.
- 1800 Farewell letter received from Maj Gen Haffner. Gen Haffner relinquishes command of division due to ill health after commanding division since it was activated on 15 Nov 42. Brig Gen McAuliffe, former commander of 101st Airborne Division, assumes command of this division.
- 2200 Detail to evacuate ammunition from cave Vic 483597 finds job impossible due to hazardous terrain for night work. 1 man injures back in attempt to complete mission.

11 Jan 1945

- 0030 Patrol of Co E that had mission to reconnoiter enemy positions south of AUERSMACHER failed. Rubber boat that was to carry men across SAAR River became punctured before crossing was completed.
- 0700 Bn mission unchanged. On defensive in right sector of Regimental Zone.

0930 Bn S-2 leaves for unit on right.

1030 Co F ordered to place 2 men on cave to their front during hours of darkness for protection.

1045 E-6 ordered to plan on raid to GROSBLITTERSDORF for tonight.

1055 Bn S-2 returns to Bn CP.

1415 Bn S-6 and S-3 leave for mortar OP in Co F area to view fire of 81mm mortars.

1500 Fatal 2 arrives at Bn CP.

1530 Fatal 2 leaves Bn CP.

1645 Small patrol of Co E postponed. Raid to GROSBLITTERSDORF all set to jump off at 0300 12 Jan 45.

1730 Bn S-6 and S-3 return to Bn CP.

0300 2nd Plat, Co E, leave Co F area for raid on GROSBLITTERSDORF.

0400 4 man patrol, Co G, leave Co area for 24 hour listening post on east side of SAAR River.

0400 Raiding party report from cemetery. No enemy action.

0510 Raiding party begins to withdraw.

0900 Report on Raid: Encountered MG fire from houses and as raiding party approaches Germans take off. Wire entanglements now in draw that approaches town.

0945 Bn S-2 and S-3 leave Bn CP for unit on our right.

1120 Fatal 6 arrives at Bn CP.

1230 Fatal 6 leaves Bn CP. Bn S-2 and S-3 return to Bn CP.

- 1335 Co G ordered to send small patrol to south of AUERSMACHER tonight.
- 1430 Small patrol, Co E, oriented to patrol North-South road east of SAAR River.
- 1450 Bn S-2 leaves for Co G.
- 1515 Fatal 8 arrives at Bn CP.

1655 Bn S-2 returns to Bn CP.

- 1800 4 man patrol from Co G return from east side of SAAR River. No Germans found. Very little activity.
- 1900 Bn S-6 holds Company Commanders meeting at Bn CP. Subject: Defensive tactics and Welfare of Men.
- 1950 G-3 OP receives 2 rounds of 88s.

2000 Fatal 3 leaves Bn CP.

2210 Co E patrol reports in to Bn CP. Encountered 12 man German patrol at (48856134). After engaging in fire fight our patrol withdraws.

2210 Co G patrol finds hill south of AUERSMACHER unoccupied.

13 Jan 45

0700 Action during night very limited. 3 TDs, 614th TD Bn, to be placed in this Bn Zone today. 1 TD placed vic ROUHLING and 2 TD placed vic IPPLING.

0920 Bn S-6 and S-3 leave for Co F CP to meet General McAuliffe.

- 1100 Bn S-6 and S-3 return from inspecting tour of troops with Gen McAuliffe.
- 1230 2 squads, Co E, to form ambush at vic 490612 to catch reported nightly patrol of Germans tonight.

1400 Squad leaders, Co E, oriented on tonight's operations.

1545 Fatal 5 arrives at Bn CP to inspect Co E.

1830 2 squads, Co E, leave on patrol mission.

2110 Order received from Fatal that this unit reverts to VI Corps. OI later.

2115 Fatal 5 leaves Bn CP.

2130 Patrol, Co E, after finding lumber yard vacated pushes on to houses north and after fire fight withdrew. No prisoners captured.

2250 Bn S-6 receives order and destroys same as ordered.

14 Jan 1945

0700 Action very limited during night.

0930 Bn S-2 leaves Bn CP to contact unit on right.

1000 Fatal 5 arrives at Bn CP. Leaves order for advance party of 1 officer per letter company and 2 officers per BnHqs to be on alert for move to area vic REICHOFFEN. Mutual relief to be inacted by this unit and TF Heron on date to be announced.

1045 Bn S-2 returns to Bn CP.

- 1115 Bn S-6 holds meeting with Company Commanders and informs them of planned
- 1615 Fatal 6 arrives at Bn CP. Advance party to leave Fatal CP at 0830 for new area, 2 1/2 ton truck to be furnished by Fatal. Companies to be on alert for German attack that PW's report to take place on 15 January 45.

1700 Fatal 6 leaves Bn CP.

- 1715 1 squad, Co F, to patrol to front during night; 1 squad, Co G, to patrol to front during night. Above notified by Bn S-2.
- 1900 Bn S-2 reports to Fatal CP.

2000 Bn S-2 returns to Bn CP.

2330 Bn S-1, 70th Infantry, arrives at Bn CP to make plans for relief.

15 Jan 1945

- 0700 Action during night very limited.
- 0730 Bn S-2 and advance party leave for new area vic REICHOFFEN.

1200 Plans for our move received from Fatal.

- 1500 Rcn elements of 2nd Bn, 275th Inf Regt, arrive at our CP.
- 1530 Co E, 275th Inf, leaves Bn CP to begin relief of Co G.

1610 Lt Rose killed by mine at road block.

1645 Co F, 275th Inf, leaves Bn CP to begin relief of Co F.

- 1655 Bn S-6 leaves with Lt Col BARTEN of 2nd Bn, 275th Inf, to go over Bn positions.
- 1735 Bn S-6 returns to Bn CP.

1955 Reserve company relief completed.

- 2145 Relief completed. F and G Companies returning to HUNDLING.
- 2200 Fatal 6 arrives at Bn CP.
- 2300 Fatal 6 leaves Bn CP.

16 Jan 1945

- 0015 Bn all closed in at HUNDLING.
- 0215 Movement Order #5 received via Lt. Lohr. Cross Division IP at 0505. IP at RJ SW of HELLIMER.
- 0800 Bn S-6 and S-1 leave HUNDLING for new area at NIEDERBRONN, France.
- 0915 Personnel carries leave HUNDLING for new area at NIEDERBRONN.
- 0930 Organic vehicles leave HUNDLING for new area at NIEDERBRONN.
- 1200 Bn S-6 and S-1 arrive at NIEDERBRONN.
- 1350 Personnelnarriers arrive at NIEDERBRONN.
- 1450 Organic vehicles arrive at NIEDERBRONN.
- 1500 The condition of bldg "De Dietrich & Cie" upon our occupation was very untidy. Signs of looting, dirty living, and improper care of civilian equipment was very obvious on part of troops of 45th Div that preceded us.

- 0030 Two German artillery shells land in Co E area, one shell made direct hit on 3rd Plateon CP of Co E injuring two men.
- 0835 One German artillery shell lands at 934389. All windows on south side of Bn CP knocked out.
- 0930 Bn S-6 and S-3 leave for Fatal CP.
- 1050 Bn S-6 and S-3 return from Fatal CP.
- 1100 Bn S-6 holds meeting with Company Commanders:
 - (a) 410th Regt (less 1st Bn) in Division and Corps reserve.
 - (b) Each company to form 2 Rcn parties to reconnoiter routes to front. Find all road blocks and mine fields.
 - (c) Officers in charge of Rcn parties:
 - Co E Lt Shelley; Lt Doggett.
 - Co F Lt Clark; Lt Morgan.
