

- 1. 3d Bn:
  - a. Relieve 1st Bn by 041000A Jan 45.
  - b. No relief to be accomplished during the hours 0530 to 0830 4 Jan 45.
  - c. With one R Co relieve reserve Co of 1st En commencing at O31400A Jan 45; relieving Co will be under command of CO 1st En until relief is completed. Relieved Co will be immediately employed by CO 3d En to take over all bridge and demolition guards for which 3d En is now responsible and to garrison IPPLING.
