**SECRET**NARRATIVE OF OPERATIONS - FEBRUARY 1945

The new Regimental CP opened at Ingwiller, France, (207746) at 1145 on 1 February 1945.

Relief of Company I and one platoon of Company L by the 2nd Battalion of the 410th Infantry was completed at 2045.

A German deserter, who gave himself up to Company K during the day, revealed that he was from the 3rd Battalion of the 12th SS Mountain Regiment, the same outfit driven out of Schillerstorf by the 410th Infantry. The prisoner stated his battalion had lost all but sixty of the original 340 soldiers who attacked there and was being replaced by a Volks Grenadier Division.

A raid on Bischoitz by Company K during the night of 1 February 45 resulted in a withdrawal without securing of prisoners because of heavy enemy SA and automatic weapons fire.

During the morning of 2 February 45, Company F sent a platoon into Mulhausen but the patrol had to pull back after receiving heavy enemy small arms and MG fire.

The 2nd Battalion of the 410th Infantry was relieved from attachment to the 410th Infantry when it assembled in Obermodern at 0800. The 1st Battalion of Company B, 781st Tank Battalion, was attached to the 2nd Battalion of the 410th Infantry at 1400.

OI #17, HQ 410th Infantry, dated 01200 February 45, ordered the 3rd Battalion to relieve elements of the 1st Battalion to the right of (east) the new boundary between Battalions by 02200 February 45, with the 3rd Battalion to assume responsibility for the new sector upon completion of relief. In accordance with this OI, the eastern elements of Company B, all but the west squad, were relieved by the 3rd Battalion at 2115 on 2 February 1945.

Two deserters from the 11th SS Regiment walked into Company C's CP at 0215 on 3 February 45.

In a spectacular 32 minute raid on Bischoitz, which ended at 0800, Company F either killed, wounded or captured the entire German garrison in town. The prisoners were from the 36th Volks Grenadier Division, which had relieved the 12th SS troops the night before in that town.

The Division Commander inspected the 2nd Battalion at 1100.

Two enemy deserters from the enemy's 36th Infantry Division walked into Company K's front lines from Mulhausen at 1315.

The Regimental AT Mine Platoon was relieved from attachment to the 1st Battalion at 1730 and reverted to the AT Company. The 1st platoon, Company B, 781st Tank Battalion, was also relieved from attachment to the 1st Battalion.

Elements of Company K relieved elements of Company I on the MLR at 2015. Company I was now in Battalion Reserve at Schillersdorf, with Company K on the left and Company L on the right of the MLR.

The 2nd Battalion was still in Regimental Reserve in the vicinity of Ingwiller.

Company C spotted a column of 40 men moving into Rothbach from Offwiller at 1643 on 4 February 45. Mortar fire placed on them caused several casualties. Otherwise, the entire sector was quiet during the 24 hour period. Two more enemy deserters walked into Company K's lines at 0400 on 5 February 1945.

Elements of Company B relieved the left platoon of Company K at 1920. In accordance with Division OI #60, which ordered the 3rd Battalion to relieve elements of the 409th Infantry in the new sector by 060600 February 45, Company I relieved elements of the 409th's 2nd Battalion at 1930.

The 3rd Battalion CP opened at Obermodern at 1825.

During 6 February 45, the regimental sector remained quiet. The 2nd Battalion CP opened at Menchhoffen at 1216.

Company A carried out a highly successful 100-man raid on Bischoltz from 0730 to 0800 on 7 February 45. The raid was executed with clocklike precision and efficiency. Eleven enemy soldiers were taken prisoner, and many were killed or wounded.

The 410th Infantry now prepared to be relieved in position by the 411th Infantry, the relief to be completed by 080600 February 45.

A platoon of Company G was motorized and relieved a platoon of the 411th Infantry as Division CP protection. Company C, 614th TDs was relieved from attachment to the 410th Infantry and attached to the 411th Infantry as of 1800.

The 3rd Battalion of the 411th Infantry relieved our 2nd Battalion at 1930. Our 2nd Battalion assembled in the vicinity of Menchhoffen and marched to Bouxwiller, closing in there at 2045.

The relief of our 3rd Battalion by the 2nd Battalion of the 411th Infantry was completed at 2000. Our 3rd Battalion assembled in the vicinity of Obermodern and moved by marching to Bouxwiller, closing in there at 2345.

Our 1st Battalion was relieved by the 411th Infantry's 1st Battalion at 2345. The 1st Battalion assembled in the vicinity (831311)(Obermodern) and

marched to Obersoultzbach, closing in at 0350 on 8 February 1945. The 411th Infantry's Commanding Officer took command of the sector at 072400 February 45. The 410th Regimental CP opened at Bouxwiller (813252) at 2400. The Regiment was now in Division Reserve.

The 2nd Platoon, Company B, 781st Tank Battalion, was relieved from attached to the 410th Infantry at 0600 on 8 February 45.

From 8 February 45 to 20 February 45 inclusive, the Regiment remained in Division Reserve. During the period, Battalions and Special Units conducted scheduled training in familiarization firing, mine detonation and demolition, village fighting and squad tactics. The entire regiment witnessed a demonstration of the new M4A3 tank, and attended the training film, "Your Job in Germany". Division Engineers demonstrated handling of German mines. An ETOUSA representative gave a lecture on "What To Do In Case of Capture."

The Division Commanding General and the Regimental Commander each inspected units of the Regiment while the Regiment was in reserve.

On 12 February 45, per Division Order, Company I was designated as the motorized company and placed on a 30 minute alert. The 1st Platoon of Company K was designated as the Division CP guard.

The 45th Division, which was on the 103d Division's left, was relieved by the 42nd Division at 2200 on 16 February 45.

Company G became the alerted, motorized Company from 1500 on 18 February 45 to 1500 on 20 February 45. Company E then relieved Company G and filled that capacity until 1500 on 21 February 45. The 1st Platoon of Company F became the Division CP guard on 18 February 45.

At 1155 19 February 45, the Regimental Commander received orders to rehearse counter-attack Plan B-2 effective at once. By 1540 the problem was completed and had been carried out successfully.

The 14th Armored Division relieved elements of the 409th Infantry on the night of 19-20 February 45. The 410th Infantry, in accordance with Division OI #62, dated 180800 February 45, was ordered to be prepared to relieve the 14th Armored in its sector on 24 hours notice. Plans were laid for the 2nd Battalion, with Companies C and B attached, to do the relieving if ordered.

The 410th Infantry moved back on the line during the night of 21-22 February 45, in accordance with Division OI #63, dated 191830 February 45, which called for the relief of the 409th Infantry and elements of the 411th Infantry in their sector, relief to be completed by 220600 February 45.

Company A, 614th TD Battalion, and the 1st Platoon, Company C, 781st Tank Battalion, were attached to the Regiment effective 211200 February 45.

At 1800 the 1st Battalion started relief of the right elements of the 411th Infantry and the left (west) squad of the 409th Infantry. This relief was completed at 2130. The 1st Battalion CP opened at Obermodern at 1835.

The 2nd Battalion began relief of the 409th Infantry, less the west squad, at 1800 and completed relief at 2205. The 2nd Battalion CP was now in Schalkendorf.

The 3rd Battalion, now in Regimental Reserve, closed into its new area in the vicinity of Obermodern at 1645, and made plans to relieve the 14th Armored Division on 24 hours notice.

Cannon Company, whose CP was in Buswiller, moved to firing positions in the vicinity of Buswiller and completed registration of all guns at 1245. The AT Company CP was in Menchhoffen.

The 409th Infantry relieved the 410th Infantry in the assignment of a motorized, alerted Company and the Division CP guard at 1500 on 21 February 45.

The 410th Infantry Regimental Commander assumed command of the sector at 2210.

The 1st Platoon, Company A, 756th Tank Battalion, was attached, and the 1st Platoon, Company C, 781st Tank Battalion, relieved from attachment at 1200 on 22 February 45.

During the 22nd of February 45, improvements were made on MLR positions and defense fire plans coordinated. At 2200 the 2nd Battalion reported an enemy machine gun at (883291). Artillery silenced it.

The sector also remained quiet on 23 February 45. Company A received 12 rounds of enemy mortar about 2210.

Company A, B, and E patrols returned during the early morning hours of 24 February 45. A Company investigated an area to the right rear of Neiffern and found no mines in a space approximately 1200 x 500 yards. Company B scouted two draws and found them heavily mined. Company E's patrol made no enemy contact but heard movement which sounded like foot troops in Kindwiller.

Company F relieved Company E on the line at 2055 on 24 February 45. One squad of Company E remained on line in the center of the sector. Company G moved into reserve positions previously manned by Company F. Company E, minus one squad, moved to Schalkendorf.

An A Company patrol returned at 0200 on 25 February 45 and reported finding un~~m~~anned enemy OP's but no mines.

During the night hours of 25 February 45, enemy shells landed in the 1st and 3rd Battalion areas.

Company C sent out two patrols during the darkness of 25-26 February 45. The 1st patrol reached within 75 yards of Neiffern, and reported 3 belts of mines. The 2nd patrol looked in vain for routes of infiltration and anti-personnel mines.

During the night hours of 26-27 February 45, a Company C patrol went into Neiffern and encountered an enemy mine field. One squad reached the first house on the east side of town and met heavy MG fire. Due to heavy enemy pressure, the patrol was forced to withdraw without prisoners. Two wounded men left in the minefield were believed to be dead.

However, the next morning, 27 February 45, outposts reported seeing one man move in the minefield. Division approved the sending of a volunteer mission of six medics and two unarmed riflemen guides to rescue the wounded man. The rescuers carried two Red Cross flags. All friendly activity halted during the rescue. The mission was not molested by the enemy and brought back the wounded man.

Company G began relief of Company F on line at 1800. Company F left one squad on the MLR. Company E relieved Company G in support positions at 1800.

Two German deserters, who stated they were from the 36th Volks Grenadier Division, gave up to the 2nd Battalion's right platoon OP (898280) at 2350 on 27 February 1945.

The situation remained unchanged on 28 February 45.

This concludes the operations of the 410th Infantry for the month of February 1945.
