Men must not drink any water except from 411th Inf water point. We now have 3 150 gallon water trailers for Bns.</p> <p>Ex O: All troops will wear helmet liners with straps up. 2nd Bn will cross IP at 0600 and will be two hours ahead of rest of column. Leave area cleaner than we found it. No souvenirs will be taken from present area. Each Bn will appoint an inspecting officer to check companies to see that area is clean and dislodged property is returned.</p> <p>All captured vehicles will be returned after move except water trailers and generator trailers. Eisenhower jackets may be worn without tie if man does not have tie. If man has tie, it will be worn with jacket.</p> <p>Billeting in new area: No Germans may be moved out of his house. Live only in hotels and barracks. Division CP, Division Arty CP and Regimental CPs only may be in private homes. The CO noted following mistakes in motor marching: Motor marching lax; uniform not consistent - make sure every man is in correct uniform; control vehicles have erratic speeds; loading of vehicles is ragged and unbalanced; proper distances are not being maintained; Ass't Drivers are too often asleep, ass't drivers will remain alert and perform the duties of Ass't Driver throughout move. Drivers will smoke only during halts. At halts men are scattered all over road. During halts men will move to right side of roads. Only drivers and March Unit, Serial Commanders etc may be on left of vehicles. Post road blocks at front and rear of each March Unit during breaks.</p>
