1 - AWARD OF SILVER STAR. Under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, the Silver Star is a warded following named individual:

Private First Class James W. Rains, 36734779, Infantry, AntiTank Company, 411th Infantry Regiment. For gallantry in action. On the
afternoon of 16 November 1944, in the vicinity of * * * , France, two
wounded men had been lying for twelve hours unattended because of the
extremely heavy enemy fire. Private First Class Rains, member of a
bazooka team, after all others had failed, volunteered to try to evacuate
the two men. With a member of the Medical Detachment he mounted a jeep
and started across an open field under heavy mortar and small arms fire.
Shell fire shattered the bumper and hood of the jeep, and the aid man was
killed instantly when small arms fire penetrated the windshield. Private
First Class Rains' helmet was dented and his clothing torn by shrapnel.
Yet he reached the wounded, loaded them into his jeep and still under
heavy fire, which riddled his vehicle, he succeeded in evacuating the
wounded to an Aid Station. Residence: Herrin, Illinois.

II -- AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL. Under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, the Bronze Star Medal is awarded following named individual:

Private First Class Ora D. Smith, 37446957, Infantry, Headquarters Company, 411th Infantry Regiment. For heroism in action. On the night or 23 November 1944, in the vicinity of ***, France, it was found tactically imperative to move the command post of the 411th Infantry Regiment to *** France. The advance party, upon reaching the new site, found it necessary to send a guide back to *** to direct the remainder of the command post personnel to the new location. Despite his knowledge that the road was heavily mined and that the eight mile drive would have to be a complished under blackout conditions, Private First Class Smith, on his own initiative and with great risk to his life, attempted the mission. He was on his way back to the old command post when his vehicle struck a road mine and he was seriously wounded. Private First Class Smith's heroic and unselfish action was in accordance with the highest standards of the military service. Residence: Allerton, Iowa.
