I was from Ottawa, Kansas. I went into the Army in August, 1944. I had Basic training at Camp Hood, Texas. After a 2 day leave, I left Kansas City, Mo for Maryland, went over seas on the Queen Elizabeth. It took 5 days. Jan, 1945

I was in 103 Infantry Division  
41st K. Co.

I served 17 months overseas. I served in Germany, France & Austria. 3 months of actual combat. Siegfried Line.

I carried ammunition, 60 mill. mortar shells. we dug holes at night, also guarded.

I was lucky to get out alive, as I saw many killed. I'm sending some pictures, but I can't remember the names of the guys with me. I got out of service in July 1946. I hope I can see someone from my regiment at the reunion. 2.000
